Botanical Bucket

Perfect for a DIY bride or brides on a budget. Brides order bulk flowers of choice that have not been arranged into personal or decorative pieces. We will do our best to honor your color choices, but due to the nature of farming, we are unable to guarantee specific colors and varieties. Flowers are available to be picked up from the farm the day prior to your event. No consultations are available for Bulk Botanicals.

À La Carte

This service is a great choice for the budget-minded couple who desire the assistance of an experienced professional by their side. Let Bee's Wing Farm craft your bridal party and family flowers while you take care of the reception décor. Or, we can create everything for you, just like a full service wedding. The difference is that Bee's Wing Farm does not provide delivery and set-up services for À La Carte orders. Even though there is a farm pick-up fee, you'll save money on delivery fees and not have to meet our minimum

for full service. The À La Carte service works great in combination with our Botanical Bucket option. Consultations for À La Carte are available up to six months prior to your wedding day.

Full Service

From the initial complimentary consultation to the big moment when you walk down the aisle, we will help you cultivate and articulate your floral vision. We provide all the arrangements and personal flowers for your event as well as delivery, set-up and rentals. There is a \$3,000 minimum. Consultations for Full Service are available up to 18 months prior to your wedding day.

We're very happy to serve more modest budgets but florals must be picked up at the farm.

We encourage our brides to choose American-grown blooms.

Anemone, hellebores

April

Anemone, bleeding heart, curly willow, daffodils, hellebore, lilac, ornithogalum, poppies, quince, ranunculus, tulips, viburnum, columbine, iris, sweet william, stock, ferns, hyacinth, flowering branches

May

Allium, bachelor buttons, baptisia, delphinium, dianthus, dusty miller, hydrangea, iris, ninebark, oregano, penstemon, peony, poppies, stock, sweet pea, viburnum, columbine, stock, dogwood, solomon's seal, mint, phlox

June

Achillea, ageratum, bells of Ireland, buddleia, bupleurum, delphinium, dianthus, dill, fennel, feverfew, forget-me-nots, godetia, hydrangea, lambs ear, larkspur, mint, monarda, nigella, orlaya, phlox, ninebark, rudbeckia, scabiosa, snapdragon, sweet pea, zinnia

July

Ammi, basil, comos, dacus, dahlia, hydrangea, joe pye weed, lambs ear, lemon verbena, lisianthus, mint, ninebark, scabiosa, tuberose, zinnia, calendula, orlaya, basil, sunflowers, lisianthus, butterfly weed, globe amaranth

August

Ammaranthus, basil, broom corn, celosia, comos, dacus, dahlias, eucalyptus, lemon verbena, mint, millet, sedum, zinnias, globe amaranth, sunflowers, lisianthus

September

Ammaranthus, basil, broom corn, celosia, dahlias, globe amaranth, Japanese anemone, lisianthus, marigolds, mint, sedum, sunflower, zinnia

October

Ammaranthus, basil, celosia, dahlias, globe amaranth, Japanese anemone, mum, heirloom mint, sedum, sunflower, zinnia

November

Geranium, heirloom mum, mint

December

Evergreens, magnolia, foraged foliage, red twig, dogwood, paperwhites, amaryllis
